- Keep in touch with your child's teacher via-email, telephone, Parent Square, notes or letters.
- Celebrate your child's success (giving verbal praise), no matter how small it may seem~~This will keep your child enthusiastic about learning and proud of their work.


Home Practice Policy : All students are asked to read nightly and practice from the Bridges Homework Book. Students are asked to work on LEXIA, MAP ACCELERATOR,S/T Math or FOOTSTEPS TO BRILLIANCE (all specific to certain grades, ask your teacher). On occasion, students may bring home unfinished classwork to complete and/or invite their family to join in on a class project.
